A PONY CLUB MINI-CLINIC WITH JILL THOMAS EVENTING October 26th and November 3rd

Come join us for a fun and educational clinic with CCI3* Eventing rider Jill Thomas.

This clinic is for all levels of eventing and even those interested in trying out the sport for the first time! Riders will be grouped according to ability.

Day 1 - The first day of the clinic will consist of a 45 minute dressage at Frying Pan Park. Group size will not exceed two riders.
